

On Line Citizen Report Frequently Asked Questions

1. *What do I do if online incident reporting is not right for me?*

If your incident is an emergency, call: 9-1-1. If non-emergency call 925-625-8060

2. *What if this happened in another city? Can I file a report using this online police reporting system?*

No. If a crime took place outside of the jurisdiction of Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office or contract cities, please call the police department for that city.

3. *What if this happened on a state Freeway?*

If this took place on a state Freeway please call the Highway Patrol Office nearest you.

4. *What is a known suspect?*

A known suspect is when you or someone else knows the person or where to find the person who committed the crime or the license plate number of the vehicle the suspect(s) were in.

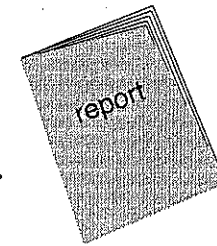

Welcome to the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office Citizen Online Reporting System. Using the Online Citizen Reporting System allows you to submit a report immediately and to print a copy of the report for free.

If this incident occurred within the jurisdiction of the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office, or one of the contract city police departments (Including unincorporated areas of Contra Costa County, **Oakley PD**, Lafayette PD, Danville PD, or Orinda PD) **and**:

- This is not an emergency
- There are no known suspects
- This did not occur on a State freeway

you are ready to file your report online.

Please read the **Online Citizen Report Frequently Asked Questions** section if any of the above **do not** apply to this incident.

Please make sure to turn off your pop-up blocking software before filing the report.

For security reasons, you must enable JavaScript to view this E-mail address, otherwise report confirmation e-mails may be blocked by AOL's spam filter.

Upon completion of this report process you will:

- See the words: "**Your online report has been submitted**" showing that your report is complete.
- Be given a report **case number**.
- Be able to print a copy of the report to keep for your records.

Please Note:

- All cases filed using the Citizen Online Reporting System will be reviewed.
- Upon review, if further investigation of your case is needed, you **may** be contacted.
- **Filing a false crime report is a crime.**
