



NOTICE

Fireworks are illegal in Contra Costa County and in the City of Oakley.

By City Ordinance (17-99, 22-99) the City of Oakley has adopted County Ordinance 44-2.002 restricting the use of fireworks.

Possession, use and sales of fireworks is prohibited.

Contra Costa Ordinance 44-2.002 Restrictions--Exceptions.

(a) No person shall possess, manufacture, sell, use or discharge, or offer to do so, any fireworks (including “dangerous,” “safe and sane,” and other fireworks) as defined in or pursuant to Health and Safety Code Sections 12502 through 12504 other than fuses (red flares) properly used by railroads, peace officers, firemen and motorists.

(b) This section does not forbid or control acts or matter expressly allowed, permitted or licensed under state law; nor does it allow acts or matter more strictly forbidden or controlled by state law or by local fire regulations. (Ord. 72-19 § 1, 1972: prior code § 3220: Ord. 684).

Fireworks are a safety and fire hazard. Fireworks will be confiscated and the responsables will be cited.
