Background and Analysis

California law and the City's Investment Policy require the City's fiscal officer to submit a quarterly investment report to the City Council at the end of each quarter. The report should contain information on all securities held, and include a statement denoting the ability of the local agency to meet its expenditure requirements for the next six months.

Fiscal Impact

City resources are organized and accounted for on a fund basis with some of those funds being restricted for specified uses and others that are unrestricted. For investment purposes, however, the funds are invested as a pool. The Investment Report for the Period Ending June 30, 2013 attached shows a combined pool balance of \$34,438,441.21. In addition, the pool had combined 4th Quarter accrued interest earnings of \$13,061.05. Interest for the period continues to reflect the lower rates currently being offered on safe, short-term investments.

The City is in compliance with the adopted investment policy and able to meet its expenditure requirements for the next six months.

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Council accept the investment report for the 4th Quarter of Fiscal Year 2012-2013.
