

Common Violations to Avoid

Avoid having a Nuisance vehicle

Wrecked vehicles on private property must be out of public view. Operable vehicles defined as having inflated tires and not visibly missing parts, should be legally parked.

Provide Adequate Garbage Service

Occupied residential and commercial properties are required to subscribe for routine garbage collection service through Oakley Disposal (925) 757-7660. Owners of property will be held responsible for ensuring tenants subscribe for garbage service.

Keep Personal Property Including Debris Out of Public View

Do not store items of personal property (including debris) in public view.

Do Not Obstruct the Right of Way

Ensure items of private property such as garbage cans, landscaping, recreational vehicles & debris do not obstruct the right of way (sidewalks, streets, and drainage ways).

Prevent Polluted Water

Do not allow standing water to become polluted. Any water source that becomes discolored or exhibits evidence of insect infestation should be reported to Contra Costa County Vector Control (925-685-9301)

Ensure Private Property Maintenance Meets Standards

Ensure lawns do not exceed 8" in height. Fences visible from the public view may not have missing boards, be leaning, sagging, fallen, decayed or be structurally unsound or unsafe for more than 30 days.

Keep Your Property Graffiti Free

It is a code violation to allow graffiti to remain on your property, help us to remove or paint over graffiti within 24 hours if possible.

Do Not House Roosters

Roosters are not allowed on any sized residential property. They are only permitted on property that is zoned for agricultural use.

Abide by Garage Sales Restrictions

Garage sales must not exceed 3 days & must take place during daylight. Signage may only be posted on private property.
