



Background and Analysis

On May 8, 2012, the Oakley City Council appointed Michael Krieg as Trustee to the Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District Board. His two-year term will expire May 7, 2014. Staff sought applicants to fill the next term by publishing information regarding the Board position on the City's website and in the local newspaper. The deadline to apply was April 11, 2014. Staff received one application from Michael Krieg which is attached for your review. The Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District Board provides that a Trustee's first term is for two years and subsequent terms can be made for two or four years.

- I want to continue making a positive contribution to the community I have lived in for 30 years.

- CCMVCD, along with a coalition of other California vector control districts, is actively working to create a model programmatic Environmental Impact Report to replace the current negative declaration for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act. I want to support CCMVCD staff in seeing that project through to completion.

Qualifications:

I've been involved in community education as a docent at the Antioch Dunes National Wildlife refuge for more than 10 years, leading dozens of tours. I've become intimately familiar with the problems of invasive species displacing our native plants and animals.

I've been an Oakley resident and homeowner for nearly 30 years, and I have a long standing interest in public policy, particularly regarding local and environmental issues such as habitat preservation, endangered species, and Delta protection.

I hold a Bachelor's degree in Anthropology from UC Santa Barbara. During my current term as Trustee, I've completed half of the courses for the Special District Leadership Academy, and expect to complete the remaining courses if reappointed.

As Oakley's current Trustee I believe I'm well equipped to represent our city on the CCMVCD Board of Trustees.
