**Project** 

**Background and Analysis** 

The City's adopted FY 2016/17 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget designates funding for various infrastructure repair and replacement projects. This is consistent with the City's goals to improve the quality of the City's public infrastructure and to enhance the quality of life for our residents.

The Oakley Recreation Center Project is a complex and high profile project for the Community. The design of this project has been underway since last year, with the goal to start the construction of the new Recreation Center this fall. The project has several key components including: grading and earthwork for the athletic field, intersection and traffic signal improvements along O'Hara Avenue, and lastly the construction of the new Recreation Center building and its associated on-site infrastructure.

In order to keep the project schedule on track, and to construct this project economically and effectively, the project will be constructed in phases. The earthwork and grading of the athletic field will be done as Phase one of the project and this work is currently underway. Phase two will be the construction of the intersection and traffic signal improvements along O'Hara Avenue. This construction will be performed while school is out of session for summer break to minimize traffic inconveniences on O'Hara Avenue. Phase three of this project will be to construct the new Recreation Center building and its associated on-site infrastructure, which will begin in the fall.

The manufacturing of the traffic signal poles will take several months and City preordered the traffic signal poles for this project from the manufacturer last month and we expect the poles to be delivered to the site by early July and ready for installation as part of this project. Fiscal Impact

The funding for this project is provided from the General Capital Fund in amount of \$8,000,000.

## **Staff Recommendation**

On May 18, 2017, XX (X) bids were received for this project. Staff reviewed the bids and determined that XXXX was the lowest responsible entity to construct this project.

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution approving the construction agreement with XXXX for an amount not to exceed \$XXX, and authorizing the City Manager to execute said agreement.

It is anticipated that this project will start after the first week of June and school closure for summer break.

Due to variables associated with construction projects, the very competitive unit prices, and to address unforeseen circumstances during the course of construction; staff further recommends that the City Council authorize staff to execute future change orders to the construction contract as necessary in an amount not to exceed \$XXXX for work beyond what is defined in the base project bid.
