

APPLICATION for APPOINTMENT to the Board of Trustees for Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District

Background Information

The Contra Costa Mosquito and Vector Control District Board is dedicated to preserving the health and welfare of residents by reducing the risk of diseases spread by insects and animals and offers services to the public to control insects and animals in a responsible, environmentally-conscious manner.

The term of the current trustee to the Contra Costa Mosquito and Vector Control District Board will expire May 6, 2018. The City of Oakley is accepting applications for a trustee to the Board until Friday, March 30, 2018 at 5 p.m.

An applicant must be a Contra Costa County taxpayer and at least the voting age of 18 with an interest in any of the following areas: public health, public policy, wetlands, farming, community education, finance, personnel or land development. The member of the Board appointed by the City shall be an elector and resident of the City of Oakley.

The Board of Trustees meet the second Monday evening of every other month. Meetings are held at the District office, 155 Mason Circle, Concord, California. Trustees may also serve on committees which meet approximately twice a month or as needed.

Trustees may be appointed for terms of two years or four years. If appointed to serve a first term, the trustee may serve for two years and may serve additional terms of two years or four years.

Trustees serve without compensation, but are allowed limited expenses for actual travel in connection with meetings or business of the Board.

It is anticipated that an appointment will be considered by the Oakley City Council April 10, 2018 during the City Council meeting scheduled to begin at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall located at 3231 Main Street, Oakley, California. All applicants are encouraged to attend this meeting to be interviewed.

Applicants should be aware that upon appointment, disclosure documents may be required to be completed for the County. For details, please contact the District office at (925) 685-9301.

All information contained in this application is public data and will be made available for public review and copying for anyone requesting it, and may be posted on the website of the City of Oakley. All information in this application will be provided to the Oakley City Council in a public forum and will be reviewed in public. It will therefore be part of the public record. Although you are not legally required to provide any of the information requested in this application, the information may be used to determine your suitability for appointment to the committee.
